Abstract

This study aimed to determine the relationship between the level of academic performance in Math 1 and Tariff 3 of BS Customs Administration Students of the Business Department at the JBLFMU (Molo), Inc. The participants of the study were the 43 fourth year BS Customs Administration students who had taken Tariff 3 and Math 1 subjects. Descriptive statistics used were mean and standard deviation. Inferential statistics employed was Pearson's r . Results revealed that the BS Customs Administration students had "good" performance in Math 1 and "fair" performance in Tariff 3, when taken as an entire group. Slightly positive and significant correlation existed between academic performance of BSCA fourth year students in Math 1 and Tariff 3.
