Abstract

This survey research aimed to determine the attitude towards and perception of the extent of the implementation of the NSTP-ROTC Program among the freshman students, school-year 2006-2007. The participants were the 251 randomly selected freshman students taking up the ROTC program. The researcher made rating scales on "Attitude Towards NSTP-ROTC Program" and "Extent of Implementation of NSTP-ROTC Program" were utilized to gather the data for the study. The descriptive statistics included means and standard deviations. Inferential statistics included the One-Way ANOVA and the Pearson's r. set at .05 alpha. Results revealed that generally, the attitude towards the NSTP-ROTC program among students was "positive." The

NSTP-ROTC among the freshman students was "highly implemented". No significant differences existed in the attitude towards the NSTP-ROTC program among students when classified according to course affiliation. No significant differences existed in the perception of the extent of implementation of the NSTP-ROTC program among students when grouped according to course affiliation. Negative and not significant relationship existed between attitude towards and perception of the extent of implementation of the NSTP-ROTC program among students.
