Abstract

This descriptive study, conducted during the first semester of school year 2005-2006 aimed to find out the business students' attitude toward research. The participants were the 53 randomly selected fourth year customs administration students at the John B. Lacson Colleges Foundation (Molo), Inc. who had taken and passed research as a subject. Data of this study were obtained using the "Attitude Towards Research Rating Scale" (Abioda, 1999 in Parago, 2003).

Descriptive statistics employed were means and standard deviations, while inferential statistics employed were the t-test and One-Way Analysis of Variance (ANOVA) set at .05 alpha level. Results revealed that generally, the BSCA students manifested a "positive" attitude towards research.

There are no significant differences existed in the attitude towards research among BSCA students when classified according to gender, high school origin, and family monthly income.
