## Abstract

This study was conducted to purposely determine the readiness of the BSCA students towards the Mock Board Exam. The variables that were considered were students' readiness towards the Mock Board Exam and students personal related factors such as sex, latest grade point average and estimated monthly family income. The respondents of the study were the fifty two (52)  $4^{\rm th}$  year BSCA students of the John B. Lacson Foundation Maritime University-Molo, Inc. Data were gathered using the researcher made survey questionnaire. Statistical tools used were the Mean and Standard Deviation for descriptive analysis and t-test and Analysis of Variance for Inferential Data Analysis. Result showed that respondents are moderately ready for the Mock Board Exam when taken as an entire group and are also moderately ready when classified according to student related variables.
