Abstract

The purpose of this study was to determine the allowance appropriation of the first year Bachelor of Science in Cruise Ship Management students of John B. Lacson Foundation Maritime University for school year 2008-2009. This research study used a questionnaire-checklist that served as an instrument to gather the needed data. The variables in the study were the respondents' sex, residential status, parents' monthly income and weekly allowance as independent variables and allowance appropriation as the dependent variable. The participants of the study were the 100 first year Cruise Ship Management students enrolled for school year 2008-2009. Respondents were determined through convenient sampling method. Percentage and mean were employed for descriptive data analysis. Results revealed that the average weekly allowance of the first year CSM

students is nine hundred eight pesos and fifty eight centavos (Php908.58) and the highest percentage of expenses from students' weekly allowance was alloted to food.
