Abstract

This descriptive study aimed to determine the benefit of Wi-Fi technology to students. The study, conducted during the first semester of school year 2010-2011, this research utilized purposive sampling and the participants of this study were the 208 students who availed Wi-Fi connection of the College of Business and College of Engineering at JBLFMU- Molo. This descriptive research focused on certain factors such as program, year level and sex as independent variable; and the benefits of WI-Fi among students at JBLFMU-Molo campus as dependent variable. This study was limited only to the benefits of having a Wi-Fi connection at the school campus especially for those who have laptops. In order to achieve the data needed for this study, a researcher-made questionnaire was devised. The questionnaire checklist was divided into two categories. The first part includes the personal information pertaining to the respondent and the second part is the list of benefits of Wi-Fi for the respondents to choose from. The results of this study revealed that the preferred benefit of Wi-Fi among students at JBLFMU-Molo when taken as a group is "Through Wi-Fi I can easily use my
