## *Abstract*

This experimental study aimed to compare the pre-test and ~~pre~~-test English language proficiency among the second year B.S. Tourism students at JBLCF-Molo, Inc., during the first semester of the academic year, 2005-2006. The participants of the study were the 32 second year B.S. Tourism students. The data needed for the study were obtained from the office of the SPS/Guidance office. Descriptive statistics used were means and standard deviations. Inferential statistics used was t-test for dependent samples set at .05 alpha level. Results revealed that the pre-test and the post-test English language proficiency among the students were found to be both "fairly proficient". No significant differences
