Abstract

This survey study was conducted to determine the extent of implementation of NSTP-CWTS share-a-home activity among students at John B. Lacson Colleges Foundation, Molo, Inc. The participants of the study were the 212 second year students of the Business Department in SY 2006-2007 from the BSCSM, BSCA, BSBA, BSMIT, and BST Programs. The data needed for the study were obtained through the use of a researcher-made questionnaire-checklist adopted from Montaño, et al (2005). Descriptive statistics used were means and standard deviation. Inferential statistics included the One-Way Analysis of Variance (ANOVA). Results showed that the students' perception of the extent of implementation NSTP-CWTS Share-a-Home activity was "implemented".
