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Abstract

The purpose of this study was to determine the perception of business students of JBLFMU-Molo on premarital sex and abortion for the school year 2009-2010. The participants of this study were the business students of JBLFMU-Molo. Frequency distribution and percentage were employed for descriptive data analysis. Results show that 71.86 percent or majority of the students of JBLFMU-Molo were not in favor of premarital sex and 92.48 percent of the students were not in favor of abortion. The study revealed however that majority or 60.96 percent of the male students favor premarital sex when respondents were grouped according to sex.
