Level of Awareness on the Effects of Pre-Marital Sex Among  
BSCSM Students In JBLFMU

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*Abstract*

This descriptive study determined the level of awareness on the effects of pre-marital sex among BSCSM students. The researchers used the 320 BSCSM students from first year to fourth year enrolled during the first semester of SY 2009-2010. It used the stratified random sampling method. A researcher made rating scale on the level of awareness on the effects of pre-marital sex was used to gather the data. Descriptive statistics used were means and standard deviations. The results showed that the students' level of awareness on the effects of pre-marital sex was "highly aware". The students' level of awareness when grouped according to their sex, high school of origin and year level was found to be "highly aware". Significant difference was found between male and female in favor of the female students.
