Abstract

This descriptive study determined the level of awareness on the effects of pre-marital sex among BSCSM students. researchers used the 320 BSCSM students from first year to fourth year enrolled during the first semester of SY 2009-It used the stratified random sampling method. researcher made rating scale on the level of awareness on the effects of pre-marital sex was used to gather the data. The students' level of awareness when grouped according to their sex, high school of origin and year level was found to be "highly aware".
