Abstract

This descriptive survey research aimed at determining the level of awareness on the importance of marine life among the 300 BSCSM students at JBLFMU-Molo Inc. A researcher prepared questionnaire was used to gather data. Frequency counts, percentage, mean, *t*-test and ANOVA were used as statistical tools. The findings of the study revealed that the respondents have "high" level of awareness on marine life when they were taken as a whole group or when grouped as to gender, place of residence and year level. No significant difference was noted in the level of awareness of marine life among the respondents when grouped according to gender, place of residence, and year level.
