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*Abstract*

The purpose of this study was to determine the level of readiness towards online classes among college students at John B. Lacson Foundation Maritime University - Molo, Inc. Iloilo City. The respondents were the two hundred nineteen 3<sup>rd</sup> year Bachelor of Science in Cruise Ship Management students this Academic Year 2020-2021. The stratified random method was used in the selection of the final respondents of the study. The results showed that the third year BSCSM students are "ready" for online learning classes. Moreover, when respondents are grouped according to sex, results showed that both male and female respondents were "ready" for online classes. While those respondents residing in both rural and urban areas also were "ready" towards online classes. It was also found out that there was no significant difference in the level of readiness and sex towards online classes among college students. Furthermore, the t-test result on the difference in the level of readiness and home location of the respondents shows that there was no significant difference in the level of readiness among college students towards online classes.
