LEVEL OF SATISFACTION OF STUDENTS ON THE PERFORMANCE OF THE SSC
OFFICERS OF JBLFMU-MOLO FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR 2009-2010

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Abstract

This descriptive research attempted to find out the level of satisfaction of students on the performance of the Student Supreme Council officers of the academic year 2009-2010. The 362 respondents came from the six programs both from Business and Engineering Colleges. The respondents were grouped according to year level and degree program. It utilized a questionnaire-checklist as data gathering instrument. Descriptive statistics is mean. Inferential statistics were One-Way ANOVA and Scheffe test. The study revealed that the respondents when taken as an entire group are satisfied on the performance of the Student Supreme Council officers. But when respondents are classified according to degree program the study revealed that BSBA and BSMIT are not satisfied. Inferential analysis showed that there were significant differences in the level of satisfaction among students on the performance of the Student Supreme Council when grouped according to year level and degree program
