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Abstract

This study aimed to determine the level of the on-the-job training (OJT) performance and personal qualities and motivation among the Bachelor of Science in Tourism (BST) students. The participants of this study were the 40 BST students who have completed their OJT course in academic years 2010-2011 and 2008-2009. The data needed for this study were retrieved from the OJT evaluation forms. The statistical tools used were mean, standard deviation, and t-test. The study revealed that the level of the OJT performance and personal qualities and motivation among the BST students when taken as an entire group and when grouped according to academic year and type of establishment is high. No significant difference was found in the level of OJT performance and personal qualities and motivation among the BST students when grouped according to academic year and type of establishment.
