Abstract

This descriptive survey study was conducted to find out the perceived extent of implementation of NSTP-CWTS among students at JBLCF-Molo, Inc.. The participants were the 195 randomly selected second year students of the Business Department enrolled during the school year 2004-2005. The data needed for the study were obtained by the use of a 15-item questionnaire checklist. Descriptive statistics used were means and standard deviations. Inferential statistics included t-test to determine the significant differences between two level categories, and the One-Way Analysis of Variance set at .05 alpha level. Results showed that generally, the perceived extent of implementation of NSTP-CWTS among students when taken as an entire group is . "implemented". There are no significant differences in the
