Abstract

The purpose of this study was to ascertain the working condition among employees at the Bureau of Customs, Iloilo City. The data of this descriptive research were gathered with the use of "Working Condition Rating Scale" designed by the researchers. The respondents of this study were the 25 employees at the Bureau of Customs, Iloilo City. Descriptive statistics employed were the frequency count, mean, and percentage. No inferential statistics was utilized in this study. The findings revealed that the working condition as perceived by the employees at Bureau of Customs, Iloilo City was "moderately positive" as an entire group and when grouped according to department affiliations such as accounting, information, and operation.
