## **Abstract**

This research study aimed to find out the preferred co-curricular activities of the Bachelor of Science in Cruise Ship Management (BSCSM) students at JBLFMU-Molo, Inc. This was conducted during the first semester of academic year 2011-2012. The participants of the study were the 200 randomly selected BSCSM students. The researchers-made questionnaire was used to gather the data. Descriptive statistics employed were the frequency count, percentage, and rank. The results showed that the students grouped in different categories had different preferences with regards to various co-curricular activities held at JBLFMU-Molo. As an entire group and when grouped according to different categories, all the BSCSM students ranked 1 the "Cruisers Club" with the exception of students who were classified as below years old who ranked the "Sangguniang Kabataan" as their top preference.
