Abstract

The study was conducted primarily to determine the preferred methods in studying among Bachelor of Science in Cruise Ship Management students of JBLFMU- Molo, Inc. as an entire group and when participants are grouped according to (a) academic performance, (b) sex grouped as male or female, and (c) student classification such as scholar and non scholar. This study employed the survey method of research using 200 randomly selected BSCSM students.

The findings of the study reveal that: the methods used among BSCSM students usually were the methods based on exam strategies followed by the methods based on communication skills, methods based on condensing information and summarizing, methods based on memorization and lastly, the methods based on time management, organization and lifestyle changes.
