Abstract

This descriptive research answered the question what is in Nueva Valencia, Guimaras that attracts tourist and guests. It also determined the factors that influenced the decision of a person when deciding to visit a tourism spot. The respondents were 15 tourists and guests that were randomly selected. Three were chosen as resort owners. A survey method was used to gather data needed for the study. A rating scale was employed to determine the factors that were highly important.
