Abstract

This investigation was undertaken to determine the passing percentage of the 19 BSCA 2005 graduates who took the BSCA Mock Examination and the 2005 Customs Brokers' Licensure Examination. The study also delved into the correlation between these variables. The results of the study showed that out of the 19 BSCA 2005 graduates who took the mock board and the customs brokers' licensure examination in March and November of 2005, respectively, 7 (36.8%) passed in both examinations. During the November 2005 Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) Customs Brokers' Licensure Examination, 221 out of 1,342 passed. The national passing percentage then was 16.47%. The study found out that a highly positive and significant relationship existed between the 2005 BSCA Mock Examination Results and the 2005 Customs Brokers' Licensure Examination.
