Abstract

The purpose of this study was to determine the level of training for global competitiveness among seafarers of the Municipality of Banate, Iloilo. The data of this descriptive research were gathered using the data-gathering instrument entitled "Training for Global Competitiveness Rating Scale" modified by the researchers. The respondents of this study were the 54 randomly selected seafarers at the Municipality of Banate, Iloilo. Descriptive statistics employed were the mean, frequency count, and percentage.
