Abstract

The participants of the study were the 118 randomly
selected third year BSCSM students of JBLFMU-Molo, Inc.
This study aimed to determine the level of self-esteem and
peer relationship among the students of John B. Lacson
Foundation Maritime University-Molo, Inc. Means, standard
deviation, and Pearson's-r coefficient of correlation were
the statistical tools used to analyze the data. The
findings of the study are as follows: 1. The level of self
esteem among the BSCSM third year students when taken as an
entire group is high. 2. The level of peer relationship
among BSCSM third year students when taken as an entire
group is high. 3. Peer-relationship is significantly
correlated with self-esteem.
