Abstract

This descriptive study had for its participants 20% of the total 1st year BSCSM Students of JBLFMU-Molo enrolled during the 1st semester of the school year, 2008-2009, which numbered 66. The investigation sought to find out the attitude towards computer games among the 1st year BSCSM Students. Means, standard deviations, and t-test for independence were the statistical tools used to analyze the data. The findings of the study are as follows: 1. The attitude towards computer games among the participants was "moderately positive" when taken as an entire group; 2. The participants, regardless of sex and monthly income of the family, have a "moderately positive" attitude; and 3. No significant differences were noted in the attitude towards computer games among the 1st year BSCSM students at JBLFMU-Molo during the first semester of school-year, 2008-2009, when grouped according to sex and monthly income of the family.
