Abstract

The study was undertaken to find out the reasons of students why they prefer playing computer games instead of attending their classes. The participants of this study were 65 students both of the College of Business and Marine Engineering Department of JBLFMU-Molo, Inc. The data of the present study were obtained by the use of a questionnairechecklist. Frequency count, percentage, and ranks were employed in descriptive analysis. Results showed that the most prevalent reasons of students were as follows: "Playing computer games is my past time habit" and "I am influenced by my friends". When categorized according to sex: males had the most number of respondents with the main reason of "Playing computer games is my past time habit" while females had only few respondents with the main reason of "I am influenced by my friends". Place of residence: urban area had the most number or participants than rural
